Dear Comber Grove families,

#### Helping children learning about their Brilliant Brains!



At Comber Grove Primary School, we are committed to developing and improving support for our pupils' **social, emotional and mental well-being**. We are therefore excited to be part of a national initiative which will involve working with a new Southwark MHST (Mental Health Support Team), to increase early help for children and young people beginning to struggle with aspects of their social and/emotional development.

In addition to providing support to parents/carers on an individual basis, the project involves the school working closely with the service to develop whole-school systems, structures and resources that support pupil well-being. This could take the form of group or whole-class work, contributing to assemblies, support for parental involvement and staff support and training.

We will be accessing the service through an assigned Educational Wellbeing Practitioner **(EWP - Izzy Garnett)** who will get to know the school community well and provide an intervention called **'Brain Buddies'** for our Year 6 pupils.

The course aims to

- develop students' understanding of what emotion regulation is

- focusing on psychoeducation and skills building in understanding, identifying and developing strategies for children to regulate their emotions through self-care, self-calming strategies and thinking strategies such as problem-solving.

We are really excited to be part of this very exciting National initiative.

### Comber Grove School Communication Procedures 2023

#### Introduction:

We at Comber Grove Primary School want to make it easy for you to get in touch with any concerns or questions you might have. This procedure, outlined below, is to make it clear and easy for parents to communicate with the school regarding any queries. We hope this explains clearly the process for expressing concerns, and clarifies which member of staff is best placed to speak to you about given issues.

We understand the importance of a strong working relationship between parents and staff in supporting all of our children in their learning. In addition to these procedures, the Headteacher (Lorram Black), and Deputy Headteacher (Joanne Fielding) look forward to speaking to parents in the playground and at school entrances. If you have concerns about your child, you should speak to your child's class teacher including any SEND.

#### Safeguarding:

At Comber Grove Primary School, it is of paramount concern that all of our children are happy and safe. If you have any concerns about the safety or wellbeing of a child, please speak to our Designated Safeguarding Leads: Lorram Black, Joanne Fielding, Judene Anchebe, Paula Trent or Clare Rowe. They are always available to speak to you.

#### **Chain of Communication**

#### Class Teacher:

You should approach your child's class teacher, in person where possible, in the first instance to discuss:

- Home learning
- Social, academic and personal progress
- Classroom and playtime incidents.
- Organisation issues, e.g. lost property which is not in 'Lost property Area'
- SEND concerns

#### SENDCO:

- Queries regarding additional needs your child may have.
- Safeguarding concerns
