Dear Comber Grove families,

An extremely warm welcome to the Summer Term 2023! We hope that you have all managed some quality time to relax over the Easter break. This really does promise to be a busy and exciting term. Class teachers will soon be sending out their curriculum news for you to help support your child's learning and also for you to know what lies ahead.

WELL DONE EYFS children

The Nursing Team who visited the school on Wednesday this week were extremely complimentary about the children in the EYFS classes. The children had their eyes tested this week and the Nurses were very impressed about how well the children behaved, knew their sounds and were able to name the letters of the alphabet confidently! **Well Done to the EYFS Team and children!**

Statutory Testing

This term sees the Statutory Testing for Year 1 Phonics Screening, Year 2 and Year 6 Standard Assessment Tests (SATS) and also the Times Table Test for Year 4. These tests will take place in school with **as much preparation**, **but as little stress as possible!**

We do ask that you support us, as always, with **homework**. Learning times tables in particular is something you can easily support with at home with games and apps, including Times Tables Rockstars. As always, **daily reading** and **positive attitudes** towards problem solving and study will always help your child throughout their primary education and help set them up to have **good learning attitudes**, **independence** and **self-discipline**.

Reading every day is the most important support you can give at home. Sharing books, talking about book characters and plots as well as listening to your child read is so valuable and makes a huge difference across the curriculum.

Labelling clothes

This is the time of year that children go out to play with coats and jumpers and then take them off and leave them all over the playgrounds! Please can you make sure coats and jumpers are labelled! Wellies, plimsoles and PE kits should be labelled too and make it quick and easy to reunite them with their owners.
