Dear Parents of Year 6 Pupils,

RE: Behaviour and Attitudes

I am writing to you as I am more than aware that the time for Year 6 to leave us is growing ever closer. In a few weeks, they will be leaving us and moving onto Secondary School.

Staff have already begun preparing them for the transition to secondary school. At Comber Grove they are the big fish in a small pond. Soon the opposite will be true.

We do not expect any of our pupils to be behaving or exhibiting inappropriate behaviour at Comber Grove Primary School and expect them to show that they can be responsible and mature members of our school community. The school has to ensure the safety of all its pupils at all times.
