Homework	 ClassDojo All homework is set on ClassDojo. If you are not linked to your child's ClassDojo account, please speak to me about it. It is <u>extremely important</u> that you are linked as we share important messages and celebrate children's efforts and achievements.
 Reading	It is important your child reads every day and that you complete the reading record regularly. Your child's home reading books will be changed every Monday (for weekend reading) Friday (for reading during the week) but your child should bring their books to school every day.
 Maths	Homework will be set which supports learning in class. This will be given out on Friday every week to be handed back the following Thursday. Whilst it is not compulsory, it is recommend that children complete homework to consolidate the week's learning.
 PE	PE will take place every Monday and Wednesday . Children may come to school in their PE kit on the days they have PE. Please ensure your child wears the correct kit.
