### **Attendance and Punctuality**

As mentioned previously, attendance is one of our school improvement priorities this year as we have noticed a decline. It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that your child attends school on a regular basis. Please ring the School Office if your child is absent and give the reason.

If you have to make a medical appointment for your child, please try to do this after school, if an appointment during the school day is unavoidable, we do ask for proof of appointment. In the interests of child protection and safeguarding we will investigate prolonged or repeated absences if we feel it is necessary and report this to the relevant authorities.

If a child's attendance drops below **90%** without any valid reason that child is then considered to be a 'persistent absentee' and their attendance will be scrutinised by Southwark Local Authority. Parents/carers will then have to attend an interview to discuss their child's attendance. We can't stress enough the importance of getting to school on time and collecting your child on time. We understand that there may be occasions when this happens but

we have found that this can become a regular pattern for some of our children. If your child arrives at school after the playground gates have closed they must be taken to the main school office and you will be required to complete a 'Late slip'. Just a reminder that if your child has sickness or diarrhoea they must be kept away from school for **48hours** after their last bout of sickness and/or diarrhoea.

#### **Contact Information/Communication**

Just a reminder to please inform the office staff if you have any changes to personal contact information such as a change of address, e-mail address or telephone number. Please make sure that the office are aware if you are having difficulty with your phone or if your phone number changes. We send most correspondence via e-mail but there are paper copies of all



letters available at the office. Please also keep us abreast of any changes for your emergency contact details should you not be available (i.e.: grandparents, child minder etc.). We must insist that school has two emergency contacts. Please make sure you inform your child's class teacher if anyone other than the usual person who collects your child is collecting them from school/nursery. Staff will not allow children to go with anyone they have not been informed about or older siblings/children who are younger than 14 years old.

Southwark have announced a month-long programme of events, presentations, visiting authors and workshops for all, including half term activities for children.







Year 1 children have enjoyed writing about Beegu! They have been practising cursive writing this Halfterm!









Application for a secondary school place for September 2024 intake

Date	What should parents/carers look out for?
1 September 2023 to Tuesday 31 October 2023	■ The admissions process starts.
	■ Contact schools for a copy of their prospectus and details of their open days/evenings. We strongly advise families to check each school's website for details on how and when they will be holding their open days/evening as this may be subject to change at short notice. Please view page 8 for further information on school open days/evenings.
	■ Apply for secondary schools by completing an online application at www.southwark.gov.uk/schooladmissions
	■ If any of the schools you have listed as one of your preferences requires a supplementary information form (SIF), you must complete and return the SIF directly to the school. You should contact the school to check their individual closing date.
Tuesday 31 October 2023, 11.59pm	■ Closing date for submitting online applications.
	You must ensure that we have received your online application and you have uploaded any additional supporting documents with it by this date.
Friday 1 March 2024	Applicants who apply on time will receive their child's offer of a school place by email after 5pm. This email will also include information on what to do next.
	■ Applicants can also view the outcome of their application during the evening at www.eadmissions.org.uk
Friday 15 March 2024	■ No action is required if you are a Southwark resident and want to accept the school place offered to your child.
	■ Should you wish to reject the offer of a school place allocated to your child, you must notify the school admissions team by email at schools.admissions@southwark.gov.uk and include your unique application reference.
Appeals	■ Check dates of appeal hearings with individual schools.
