Dear Comber Grove families,

Message to Comber Grove Primary School Community regarding Consultation on the proposed closure of Comber Grove Primary School on 31st August 2024

On Tuesday, 07/11/2023, you would have all received a letter from the Local Authority's Director of Children's Services (Alasdair Smith) on behalf of Southwark Council who are **consulting** on the **proposed closure** of Comber Grove Primary School in **August 2024**.

There are **five (5)** stages to the consultation process and the consultation which began on Monday, 6th November 2023 is currently **Stage 1** which will last for six (6) weeks.

Stage 1: Consultation

It is a statutory requirement for governors to consult any parties they think are appropriate before publishing concrete proposals. The consultation will last for **6 weeks** to allow the widest possible canvassing of views. The purpose of the consultation is to seek the views of and engage with those that will be directly affected by the proposed closure of Comber Grove Primary School. It is also an opportunity for interested parties to suggest other options for consideration on the proposed closure of Comber Grove Primary School in August 2024. This period will run from Monday, 06th November **to Friday, 15th December 2023.**

There will be further meetings over the forthcoming weeks to ensure that you have the chance to receive information and able to ask questions.




