Anti-Bullying Week 2023

It was great to see children and staff in their odd socks on Monday in support of Anti-Bullying Week.

This week as a school children learnt what bullying is: 'The repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power'.

Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological. We discussed that bullying can happen face to face or online.

We also defined banter as: The playful and friendly exchange of teasing remarks. We said it is NOT banter if:

- 1. You would be upset if someone said it to you
- 2. It's hurtful
- 3. You're not friends
- 4. Someone's asked you to stop
- 5. The target isn't laughing
- 6. It focuses on someone's insecurities

Children were able to identify who they could speak to if they were concerned that bullying was taking place and they were vocal in their stance that Bullying is not welcome at CGP!


Access to computers for consultation comments
