We had an amazing match. I'm grateful that Mr Shae took me! - Djenebou



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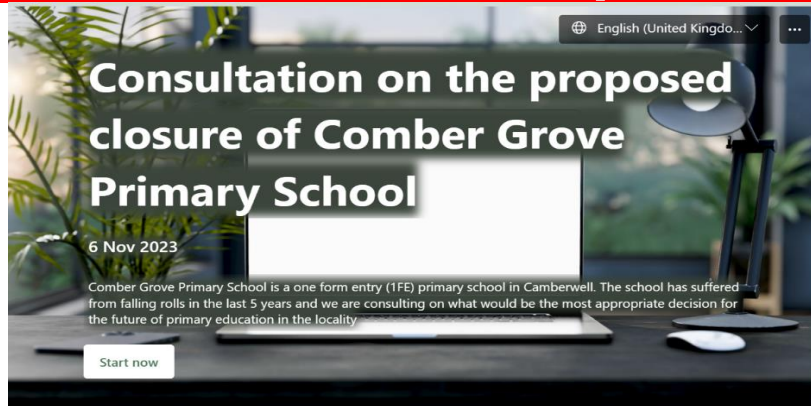
