CASP Raffle Tickets-£2 per ticket


CASP have raffle tickets for sale which will be in the school office from Monday, 15th January 2024. The prizes are:

Working Together

At Comber Grove Primary School we always work together to ensure our pupils are happy and safe. We also work together to ensure families have a voice so their concerns, views and opinions are heard.

In the first instance you can always approach the Headteacher (Mr Black) about any concern or question you may have. Mr Black will then offer advice and support or he will guide you to the right person for the appropriate advice and support.

You can also raise concerns, views and opinions using the following process:

STEP 1: We always attempt to resolve any issues or concerns at classroom level first. Our class teachers are always ready to help.

STEP 2: If Step 1 is not successful then you can request to meet with Miss Fielding (Deputy Headteacher), Miss Saunders (Assistant Headteacher) or Mrs Anchebe (SENDCo).

STEP 3: On the very rare occasion that Steps 1 & 2 do not bring a satisfactory conclusion to the issue then a request can be made to meet with Mr Black (Headteacher).
