## RE: Year 5 Swimming

Swimming is an important part of the Physical Education curriculum and we have organised a fantastic opportunity for your child to either learn to swim or strengthen their ability further.

All children in Year 5 started their swimming lessons on **Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> January 2024** at Camberwell Leisure Centre, a local venue. We would like to take this opportunity to ask you to further support us to ensure that your child's swimming lessons continue to be enjoyable for all.

- Please ensure that your child brings **appropriate swimwear, a towel, and a swimming cap**. Your child may also bring goggles. Unfortunately, the school is not in a position to provide swimwear or towels etc. for children.
- Please be encouraged to **pack an extra towel** for your child to stand on while changing. This will hopefully prevent items falling into puddles of water in the changing rooms.
- Please also pack a **plastic bag** in their bag so that they can put their uniform in so it doesn't slip through the bench while they are swimming.
- All parents/ carers should **talk to their children about drying carefully** and dressing in all their clothes before leaving the swimming pool.
- **For safety reasons children must not bring any kind of spray or deodorant etc. and must not wear jewellery e.g. earrings (we cannot remove earrings for your child).**
- If your child is Asthmatic and requires an inhaler it must be available in school and taken to the swimming pool.
