Dear Year 6 families,

As you know, our Year 6 children will be sitting their Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) starting on Monday, 13th May 2024.

The children have worked really hard in order to prepare for their tests, and it is very important to support them as much as possible.

Please could we ask parents to help us prepare the children as best we can for the week of SATS.



- **Sleep** The children need adequate sleep. They also need time to relax before they go to bed. We would recommend ten hours sleep a night and no television, computer, or screen use for at least an hour before they go to bed. Children sleep better if their phone is in another room to their bedroom. We need children to be fresh and well rested.
- Breakfast We will be offering free breakfast for all year 6 pupils from Monday 13th to Thursday 16th May. Year 6 pupils are asked to come for breakfast between 8:00am and 8:30am during SATs week. Coming together as a team will help relax children before their tests start and make sure that all children arrive on time.
- Revision please ensure the children continue to do homework and revision (including reading and Maths activities) for a short period every day.

It's important to make sure that you don't place too much pressure on your child. The more relaxed you are, the more relaxed your child will be, which means they are likely to perform better during SATs week.


